VIRIDIAN MUNICIPAL MANAGEMENT DISTRICT

The Board of Directors of Viridian Municipal Management District will hold a regular meeting on **Tuesday, February 10, 2026, at 12:00 p.m., at the Lakeview Event and Conference Center, 1200 Viridian Park Lane, Bldg. A, Arlington, Texas 76005**, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public comment(s) – In accordance with the Open Meetings Act, Directors are prohibited from acting on or discussing any new items brought before them at this time. Citizens' comments will be limited to 3 minutes. Comments about any of the agenda items are appreciated by the Board of Directors and may be taken into consideration at this time or during that agenda item. If you desire to address the Board, please complete and submit a Public Input Form, a copy of which is attached hereto, to jfinke@abhr.com. All remarks and questions addressed to the Board shall be addressed to the Board as a whole and not to any individual member thereof.
2. Consent Agenda - Items are considered self-explanatory and non-controversial and will be enacted in a single motion. There will be no separate discussion of these items unless so requested by at least one member of the Board, in which case such item will be removed from consent and considered after action on the remaining consent items:

3. Viridian Sailing Center Foundation Report, and take any appropriate actions.
4. Consider Viridian Residential Association matters, including landscaping, art installation, including potential approval of amendment to Ground Lease Agreement, and request for VRA events to be held on District property; take any related action.
5. Consider request for installation of street and wall banners for the Louise and Jackson multi-family areas and approval of any agreements necessary in connection therewith.
6. Committee Reports and related matters.
7. Discuss Viridian Beach access and/or repurposing matters, and take any appropriate action.



 - a. Status of construction of improvements projects within the District; authorize issuance of notices to contractors;
 - b. Authorize preparation of construction plans and specifications;
 - c. Approve construction plans and specifications and advertising/soliciting for bids for contracts, including pedestrian facilities at Meadow Hawk Dr.
 - d. Approve award of construction contracts and issuance of notices to proceed as follows:
Public Bids- ≥ \$150,000.01 – None;
Solicited Bids – \$25,000.01 - \$150,000.00 – None; and
Under \$25,000.00 – None;
 - e. Approve three party agreement(s), community facilities agreement(s), and escrow agreement(s) with City of Arlington and/or City of Fort Worth, and adopt resolutions regarding same as necessary;
 - f. Approve pay applications and change orders to construction contracts for improvement projects;

 - g. Approve certificates of substantial completion and authorize final acceptance of improvements;

 - j. Discuss maintenance and authorize preparation of consultant recommendations; consider approval of proposals, contracts and invoices for payment under maintenance and repair projects;
