ROLLING V RANCH WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 3 OF WISE COUNTY


The Board of Directors of Rolling V Ranch Water Control and Improvement District No. 3 of Wise County will hold a regular meeting on **Thursday, February 12, 2026, at 1:00 p.m.**, at 4001 Maple Avenue, Suite 270, Dallas, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public comments.
2. Approve minutes.
3. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills and review of investments.
4. Accept annual disclosure statements for Investment Officer and bookkeeper.
5. Conduct annual review of Investment Policy and adopt Resolution Regarding Annual Review of Investment Policy.
6. Review, revise, and adopt Resolution Establishing the Authorized Depository Institutions and Adopting List of Qualified Broker/Dealers with Whom the District May Engage in Investment Transactions.
7. Engineering matters, including preparation of plans and specifications, approval of plans and specifications, advertisement for bids, bid review, contract award, Pay Estimates and Change Orders, acceptance of projects, including status of construction of water well field.
8. Operation of District facilities, including billings, repairs, and maintenance, and approval of account agreements with Central Bank.
9. Deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, requests for service, utility commitment letters, leases or other acquisitions or dispositions of real property rights.
10. West Fork Public Utility Agency Matters, including:
 - a. authorize publication of notice of intent to create the West Fork Public Utility Agency; and
 - b. authorize publication of notice of intent to amend concurrent order creating the West Fork Public Utility Agency.
11. Development matters, including report regarding development in the District, approval of development financing agreements, amendments to development financing agendas, assignments of development financing agreements, and consents to assignment.
12. Attorney's report.

14. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize appropriate action.
15. Meeting schedule.
