1. Public comments.
2. Approve minutes of prior meetings, including, February 18, 2025 (Regular), and March 4, 2025 (Greenbelt), and March 10, 2025 (Chelford).
3. Security services matters, including:
 - a. report from Harris County Sheriff's Office; and
 - b. update on the implementation of signs prohibiting commercial vehicles from parking overnight.
4. Park maintenance matters, including authorize proposals.
5. Lighting maintenance and repair, including authorize proposals.

 - c. Little Villa Wetland improvement project, including:
 - i. Phase II improvements;
 - d. pressure washing in the District; and
 - e. median improvements.
