The Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 222 will hold a regular meeting on Thursday, March 19, 2026, at 11:30 a.m., at the Wortham Village Clubhouse, 10911 Wortham Blvd., Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Approve Minutes.
2. Input/inquiries from District customers.
3. Landscaping, park, and lake matters in the District.
4. Amended Landscape Management Agreement.
5. District security, including approve Agreement with Flock Safety for license plate readers.
6. Tax assessment and collections matters, delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
7. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of bills, review of investments.
8. Website and communication matters.
9. Operation of District facilities, including billings, repairs and maintenance, customer correspondence, and water accountability.
10. Hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
11. Conduct Annual Review of Drought Contingency Plan.
12. Review Critical Load Spreadsheet for District's facilities and authorize annual filing.
13. Authorize operator to prepare water loss audit.
14. Approve engineer's report, including:
 - a. deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, requests for service or utility commitment letters;
 - b. consider upgrading inlets at the Fallbrook Detention Facilities;
 - c. Seven Springs Lake bulkhead;
 - d. installation of smart meters;
 - e. traffic study; and
 - f. other engineering matters.
15. Review revised contracts for sanitary sewer trunkline agreements, and authorize appropriate action, if necessary.
16. Matters relating to North Harris County Regional Water Authority, including pumpage fees, surface water conversion program and issuance of bonds.
