ROLLING V RANCH WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 2 OF WISE COUNTY


The Board of Directors of Rolling V Ranch Water Control and Improvement District No. 2 of Wise County will hold a regular meeting on **Tuesday, April 7, 2026, at 12:00 p.m.**, at 4001 Maple Avenue, Suite 270, Dallas, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public comments.
2. Approve minutes.
3. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills and review of investments.
4. Adopt operating budget for fiscal year ending April 30, 2027.
5. Engagement of auditor for preparation of audit report for fiscal year ending April 30, 2026.
6. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
7. Engineering matters, including preparation of plans and specifications, approval of plans and specifications, advertisement for bids, bid review, contract award, Pay Estimates and Change Orders, and acceptance of projects.
8. Review and approval of Bond Application Report; and adoption of Resolution Authorizing Application to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality For Approval of Project and Bond; and authorize issuance of Series 2026 Bond Anticipation Note.
9. Deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, requests for service, utility commitment letters, leases or other acquisitions or dispositions of real property rights.
10. Operation of District facilities, billings, repairs, and maintenance, including hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
11. Conduct Annual Review of Drought Contingency Plan.
12. Development matters, including report regarding development in the District, approval of development financing agreements, amendments to development financing agreements, assignments of development financing agreements, and consents to assignment.
13. Communications report.
14. Attorney's report.
