KAUFMAN COUNTY FRESH WATER SUPPLY DISTRICT NO. 1-B


The Board of Directors ("Board") of Kaufman County Fresh Water Supply District No. 1-B will hold a regular meeting on Thursday, April 24, 2025, at 6:30 p.m., at 9558 Helms Trail, Suite 100, Forney, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Confirm quorum; Call to order.
2. Public comments.
3. Review and approve Minutes of February 27, 2025, and March 27, 2025, Board meetings.
4. Patrol activity report by Kaufman County Precinct No. 2 Constable's Office and take any related action.
5. Engineering matters, including the following items and/or actions relating to, among other projects, traffic signage, 2024 High Priority Sanitary Sewer Repairs, and beaver dam removal and drainage remediation:
 - a) design;
 - b) approve construction plans and specifications and authorize advertisement for bids;
 - c) review bids and award contract;
 - d) approve pay estimate, change order and final acceptance and direct Engineer to notify insurance company of new facility;
 - e) accept certificate of completion and authorize final acceptance of facilities, if necessary;
 - f) deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, requests for service or utility commitment letters; and
 - g) authorize and/or ratify repair and maintenance of District facilities, as necessary.
6. Review and acceptance of Operator's report (District and Joint Facilities); address utility service and billing matters, including customer requests, appeals and collections; and take any appropriate related action.
7. Review Critical Load facilities.
8. Review Emergency Preparedness Plan.

Consider approval of Second Amendment to Joint Utility and Wholesale Allocation Agreement, contemplating the cost-sharing agreement by and between the District and Kaufman County Fresh Water Supply District No. 1-C related to buyout of the Interim Lease Agreement for Wastewater Treatment Plant by and between AUC Group, L.P., and Kaufman County Fresh Water Supply District No. 1-A.
11. Authorize renewal of District's insurance policies, including review of Engineer's list of District facilities to be insured.
12. Financial and bookkeeping matters (District and Joint Facilities), including payment of bills and review of investments.
13. Tax assessment and collections matters.
14. Report on District website.
15. Consider matters for placement on future agendas.
16. Adjourn.
