11. Status of Application to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality For Approval of Project and Bonds; and discuss BAN bids and award sale of BAN to lowest bidder.
12. Deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, requests for service, utility commitment letters, leases or other acquisitions or dispositions of real property rights.
13. Operation of District facilities, billings, repairs, and maintenance, including hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
14. Approve Consumer Confidence Report and authorize operator to deliver Consumer Confidence Report and file certificate of delivery with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.


