

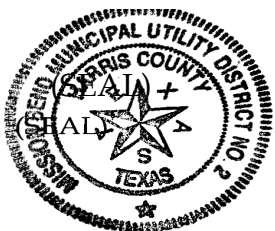
NOTICE OF MEETING

MISSION BEND MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 2

The Board of Directors of Mission Bend Municipal Utility District No. 2 will hold a regular meeting on **Tuesday, June 18, 2024, at 6:00 p.m.**, at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, Suite 2400, in the Guadalupe Room, Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public comments.
2. Approve minutes of prior meetings, including, May 21 (Regular), June 4 (Special), June 4 (Greenbelt), and June 10 (Chelford).
3. Security services matters, including:
 - a. report from Harris County Sheriff's Office;
 - b. update on the implementation of signs prohibiting commercial vehicles from parking overnight; and
 - c. approve Interlocal Agreement for Law Enforcement Services.
4. Park maintenance matters, including authorize proposals.
5. Lighting maintenance and repair, including authorize proposals.
6. District surveillance camera matters, including authorize proposals.
7. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills and review of investments.
8. Discuss Association of Water Board Directors summer conference, approve reimbursement of eligible expenses, and authorize attendance at winter conference.
9. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.

 - d. water plant no. 1 ground storage tank rehabilitation;
 - e. storm water quality inspections and permitting for Terra del Sol, Section 8; and
 - f. requests for service or utility commitment letters.

- a. Magnolia Park maintenance, including:
 - i. Phase III improvements; and
 - ii. park access options.
 - b. Mission Bend Greenbelt Trail improvements project, including:
 - i. west side Trail expansion project.
 - c. Little Villa Wetland improvement project, including:
 - i. Phase II improvements.
 - d. Pressure washing in the District; and
 - e. Median improvements.

- a. Places for People: 2023 Call for Projects, including approve Interlocal Agreements;
 - b. Places for People: 2024 Call for Projects, including approve Resolutions of Funding Commitment and authorize submittal; and
