The Board of Directors of Elm Ridge Water Control and Improvement District of Denton County will hold a regular meeting on Thursday, June 20, 2024, at 6:00 p.m., at 1230 Brendan Dr., Little Elm, Texas 75068, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public comment(s) – In accordance with the Open Meetings Act, Directors are prohibited from acting on or discussing any new items brought before them at this time. Citizen’s comments will be limited to 3 minutes. Comments about any of the agenda items are appreciated by the Board of Directors and may be taken into consideration at this time or during that agenda item. Please complete a Public Input Form if you desire to address the Board. All remarks and questions addressed to the Board shall be addressed to the Board as a whole and not to any individual member thereof.
2. Presentation of swearing-in ceremony for new officer for Elm Ridge Water District Police Department.
3. Adopt List of Local Government Officers.
4. Consent Agenda:

 - e) Approval of construction pay application(s) and change order(s) to construction contracts, including pay applications and change orders to current construction contracts.



 - i) Approval of final plats and amendments to plats.
 - j) Engineering Contracts.
 - k) Approvals and Permits.
 - l) Miscellaneous.
6. Operator's report regarding the Artesia Utility System, including status of maintenance of water facilities; and authorize expenditure of funds for operation and maintenance of water facilities.
 7.
