

**NOTICE OF MEETING
DENTON COUNTY FRESH WATER SUPPLY DISTRICT NO. 11-C**

The Board of Directors ("Board") of Denton County Fresh Water Supply District No. 11-C will hold a regular meeting on **Thursday, June 27, 2024, at 12:00 Noon at 10210 N. Central Expressway, Suite 300, Dallas, Texas**, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public comment – In accordance with the Open Meetings Act, Directors are prohibited from acting on or discussing any new items brought before them at this time. Citizen’s comments will be limited to 3 minutes. Comments about any of the agenda items are appreciated by the Board and may be taken into consideration at this time or during that agenda item. Please complete a Public Input Form if you desire to address the Board. All remarks and questions addressed to the Board shall be addressed to the Board as a whole and not to any individual member thereof.
2. Review and approve Minutes of Board meeting held May 23, 2024.
3. Consider appointment of director to fill vacancy on Board, and approve Sworn Statement, Bond and Oath of Office of new director.
4. Reorganize Board and elect officers.
5. Authorize filing of District Registration Form with Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (“TCEQ”).
6. Approve annual audit report for fiscal year ended February 29, 2024.
7. Update regarding status of defeasance of District bonds, and take any appropriate action regarding same.
8. Review and approve General Manager's report regarding general management affairs of the District; consider customer utility and trash service billing complaints/requests and appeals; consider update on drought restriction enforcement; consider report from FWSD Interlocal Committee; consider update on Little Elm Police Department patrol services; and authorize actions and expenditures as necessary.



9. Discuss and approve the purchase of District security equipment, including Flock Safety camera systems.
10. Review and approve proposed 2024-25 budget for services under Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for Patrol Services.
11. Review and approve proposed 2024-25 budget under Joint Interlocal Agreement for School Resource Officers.
12. Approve Water Conservation Plan annual report and water conservation implementation report.
13. Adopt Resolution adopting amended Drought Contingency Plan.
14. Discuss status of District water and wastewater system and TCEQ notice regarding compliance.
15. Engineering matters, including the following actions relating to District projects:
 - a) Design;
 - b) Approve construction plans and specifications and authorize advertisement for bids;
 - c) Review bids and award contract;
 - d) Approve pay estimates, change orders and final acceptance and direct Engineer to notify insurance company of new facility;
 - e) Accept certificates of completion and authorize final acceptance of facilities, if necessary;
 - f) Deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, requests for service or utility commitment letters; and
 - g) Authorize and/or ratify repair and maintenance of District facilities, as necessary.
16. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of bills and review of investments.
17. Tax collection matters, including collections report.
18. Authorize delinquent tax attorney to proceed with collection of delinquent taxes.
19. Report on District website.

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20. Consider procedures for bidding new waste collection services contract, and the taking of action in connection therewith.
21. Consider status of *City of Aubrey, Texas and Town of Providence Village, Texas v. Denton County Fresh Water Supply District No. 11-C, et al.*, and the taking of action in connection therewith.
22. Consider matters for placement on future agendas.
23. Adjourn.
