BELMONT FRESH WATER SUPPLY DISTRICT NO. 2 OF DENTON COUNTY


The Board of Supervisors of Belmont Fresh Water Supply District No. 2 of Denton County will hold a regular meeting on Wednesday, July 8, 2026, at 6:30 p.m., at 1301 Homestead Way, Argyle, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public comment(s) – In accordance with the Open Meetings Act, Supervisors are prohibited from acting on or discussing any items brought before them at this time. Each citizen's comments will be limited to three (3) minutes. Comments about any of the agenda items are appreciated by the Board of Supervisors and may be taken into consideration at this time or during that agenda item. All remarks and questions addressed to the Board shall be addressed to the Board as a whole and not to any individual member thereof.
2. Discuss stop signs on Parkside Drive, and the taking of any action necessary or appropriate in connection therewith.
3. Review of consent agenda, and the taking of any action necessary or appropriate in connection therewith:
 - a. minutes of June 10, 2026, Board of Supervisors Meetings;
 - b. tax collections report;
 - c. developer's residential report, including status of lot development and lot/home sales; and
 - d. All-American Dogs, Inc., patrol activity report.
4. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including approval of Bookkeeper's Report and payment of bills, and take any action necessary or appropriate in connection therewith.
5. Developer's report regarding status of commercial development.
6. Special Action Items:
 - a. adopt Order Adopting Procedures for Post-Issuance Compliance;
 - b. annual Review of Procedures for Continuing Disclosure Compliance;
 - c. approve Annual Report and authorize filing of same in accordance with the District's Continuing Disclosure of Information Agreement, and as required by SEC Rule 15c2-12;
 - d. renewal of District's insurance policies;
 - e. discuss and consider adoption of signage request guidelines;
 - f. discuss District's Code of Ethics and Reimbursement Guidelines, and the taking of any action appropriate therein; and
 - g. discuss Association of Water Board Directors summer conference, approve reimbursement of eligible expenses, and authorize attendance at winter conference.
7. Discussion regarding District police services and the taking of any action necessary or appropriate in connection therewith.

 - a. approval of deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, requests for service or utility commitment letters;
 - b. proposals for engineering services; and
 - c. other engineering matters.
9. Reports and recommendations from Triton and Website Committee; discussion on Community Tracker items; social media updates; and the taking of any action necessary or appropriate in connection therewith.
10. Discussion regarding a request for permission to use a section of Old Justin Road for the Cross Timbers Marathon, and the taking of any action necessary or appropriate in connection therewith.
11. Items for placement on future meeting agenda.
