5. Maintenance of lakes and channels, including:
 - a. Rehabilitation for Lake 10.

7. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
8. Adopt Resolution Regarding Development Status for 2025 Tax Year.
9. Operation of District facilities, including
 - a. billings, repairs, and maintenance;
 - b. hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and for rate order violations and authorize termination of service and/or penalties; and
 - c. North Fort Bend Water Authority matters, including Water Provider Conservation Program updates.
10. Engineering matters, including preparation of plans and specifications, approval of plans and specifications, advertisement for bids, bid review, contract award, Pay Estimates and Change Orders, and acceptance of projects, if appropriate, including:
 - a. Water Plant Expansion;
 - b. Lakemont Stormwater Reuse Pump Station Rehabilitation;
 - c. Maintenance and Capital Improvement Plan; and
 - d. biannual inspection of District facilities.
11. Authorize acceptance and conveyance of easements/deeds/utility deeds, approval of abandonment of easement or facilities, and review of plans.
12. Park project and recreational facility matters, including preparation of plans and specifications, approval of plans and specifications, advertisement for bids, bid review, contract award, Pay Estimates and Change Orders, and acceptance of projects, if appropriate, including:
 - a. Creekside Park at Lakemont.

13. Phase II Small MS4 General Permit and Storm Water Management Plan, including status of compliance, necessary training, and public comment.
14. Report regarding legislative matters.
