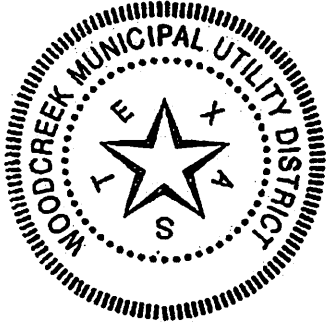
1. Public comments;

3. Financial Advisor's Report, including:
 - (a) Receive 2026 Tax Rate Analysis; and
 - (b) Call public hearing on proposed 2026 tax rate and authorize publication of Notice of Hearing;
4. Tax Assessor/Collector's Report, including authorization of payments from the Tax Account;
5. Bookkeeper's report, including authorization of payment of the District's bills and approval of Investment Report;
6. Engineer's report, including:
 - (a) Status of pending development projects;
 - (b) Status of City of Houston GRP matter; and
 - (c) Approve Pay Estimates, bidding authorization, project awards, and related matters, as necessary;
7. Drainage Maintenance report;
8. Operator's report, including:
 - (a) Authorize termination of water and sewer service to delinquent accounts;
 - (b) Approve fence repair at wastewater treatment plant; and
 - (c) Discuss security at sewer plant and take any necessary action;
9. Attorney's report, including:
 - (a) Status of City of Houston Litigation; and
 - (b) Approve Resolution Evidencing Review of Investment Policy and Strategies;
10. Such other matters as may come before the Board.

If, during the course of the meeting covered by this Notice, the Board should determine that a closed or executive session of the Board should be held or is required in relation to any agenda item included in this Notice, then such closed or executive meeting or session, as authorized by the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 551, as amended (the "Act"), will be held by

the Board at the date, hour, and place given in this Notice concerning any and all subjects for any and all purposes permitted by Subchapter D of said Act.
