The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 122 will hold a regular meeting on **Wednesday, September 16, 2026, at 10:30 a.m.**, at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, Suite 2400, in the Navasota Conference Room, Houston, Texas, with supplementary access via Zoom teleconference and/or videoconference*, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following:

1. Public comments.**
2. Approve minutes.
3. Receive reports from Directors.
4. Website communication matters.
5. Engage auditor to conduct audit for fiscal year end September 30, 2026.
6. District technology matters.
7. Maintenance of lakes and channels, including:
 - a. Rehabilitation for Pond 10.
8. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including:
 - a. payment of the bills and review of investments;
 - b. adopt budget for fiscal year end September 30, 2027;
 - c. conduct annual review of Investment Policy and adopt Resolution Regarding Annual Review of Investment Policy; and
 - d. review, revise, and adopt Resolution Establishing the Authorized Depository Institutions and Adopting List of Qualified Broker/Dealers with Whom the District May Engage in Investment Transactions.
9. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, payment of tax bills, and hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers, and authorize termination of service.
10. Conduct public hearing regarding District's tax rate, adopt Order Levying Taxes, and authorize execution of Amendment to Information Form.
11. Amend Maintenance Agreement with Lakemont Community Association, Inc.
12. Operation of District facilities, including:
 - a. billings, repairs, and maintenance;
 - b. hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and for rate order violations and authorize termination of service and/or penalties;
 - c. North Fort Bend Water Authority matters, including Water Provider Conservation Program updates;
 - d. installation of smart meters; and

- e. adopt Amended Rate Order, if appropriate.
- 13. Park facilities report and related agreements and proposals.
- 14. Engineering matters, including preparation of plans and specifications, approval of plans and specifications, advertisement for bids, bid review, contract award, Pay Estimates and Change Orders, and acceptance of projects, if appropriate, including:
 - a. Lakemont Stormwater Reuse Pump Station Rehabilitation; and
 - b. Maintenance and Capital Improvement Plan.
- 15. Authorize acceptance and conveyance of easements/deeds/utility deeds, approval of abandonment of easement or facilities, and review of plans.
- 16. Phase II Small MS4 General Permit and Storm Water Management Plan, including status of compliance, necessary training, and public comment.
- 17. Schedule biannual inspection of District facilities.
