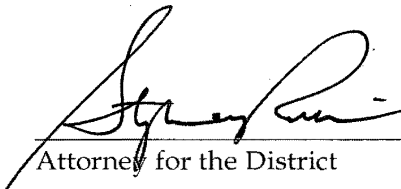
TRADITION MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 2B OF DENTON COUNTY

 - g. authorize advertisement for sale of the Series 2025 Unlimited Tax Road Bonds and schedule bond sale.
