


NOTICE OF MEETING
DENTON COUNTY FRESH WATER SUPPLY DISTRICT NO. 11-B

The Board of Directors ("Board") of Denton County Fresh Water Supply District No. 11-B will hold a regular meeting on **Monday, October 21, 2024, at 4:30 p.m. at 1230 Brendan Drive, Little Elm, Texas**, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public comment - In accordance with the Open Meetings Act, Directors are prohibited from acting on or discussing any items brought before them at this time. Citizen's comments will be limited to 3 minutes. Comments about any of the agenda items are appreciated by the Board and may be taken into consideration at this time or during that agenda item. Please complete a Public Input Form if you desire to address the Board. All remarks and questions addressed to the Board shall be addressed to the Board as a whole and not to any individual member thereof.
2. Approve Minutes of September 16, 2024, Board meeting.
3. Update on preparation for November 5, 2024, Election Regarding Fire Protection Plan and Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for Fire Protection Services.
4. Approve First Amendment to Solid Waste and Recycling Services Agreement with Waste Connections Lone Star, Inc.
5. Review and approve General Manager's report regarding general management affairs of the District; consider customer utility and trash service billing complaints/requests and appeals; consider reports from FWSD Interlocal Committee/Public Safety Committee; consider update on Little Elm Police Department patrol and City of Aubrey fire services; and authorize actions and expenditures as necessary.
6. Engineering matters, including the following item and actions relating to, among other projects, paving and utility facilities to serve Northlake Estates, Phase 3 and pavement repairs in Northlake Estates, Phase 2, on Ordonez Drive:
 - a) Design;
 - b) Approve construction plans and specifications and authorize advertisement for bids;
 - c) Review bids and award contract;
 - d) Approve pay estimates, change orders and final acceptance and direct Engineer to notify insurance company of new facility, as appropriate;
 - e) Accept certificate of completion and authorize final acceptance of facilities, if necessary;
 - f) Deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, requests for service or utility commitment letters; and
 - g) Authorize and/or ratify repair and maintenance of District facilities, as necessary.

7. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of bills and review of investments.
8. Approve amended general operating budget for fiscal year ending February 28, 2025.
9. Tax collection matters, including collections report.
10. Report on District website, including Website Committee report.
11. Director reports.
12. Consider video recording monthly Board meetings, and take any action in connection therewith.
13. Consider status of claim filed for pavement failure on Ordonez Drive, and the taking of action in connection therewith.
14. Consider status of *City of Aubrey, Texas and Town of Providence Village, Texas v. Denton County Fresh Water Supply District No. 11-B, et al.*, including approval of Fifth Amendment to Fire Protection Services Agreement; approval of documents related to current litigation; and the taking of action in connection therewith.
15. Consider update regarding *Denton County Fresh Water Supply District No. 11-B, et al. v. Paloma Creek Homeowners Association, Inc.*, and the taking of action in connection therewith.
16. Consider matters for placement on future agendas.
17. Adjourn.
