

AMENDED ORDER ESTABLISHING PUBLIC COMMENT POLICY

The Board of Directors of Frisco West Water Control and Improvement District of Denton County met in regular session, open to the public, after due notice, outside the boundaries of the District, on the date hereinafter set out; whereupon the roll was called of the members of the Board of Directors, to-wit:

All members of the Board were present with the exception of Director Cardwell.

WHEREUPON, among other business conducted by the Board, Director Walls introduced the order set out below and moved its adoption, which motion was seconded by Director Nugent and after full discussion and the question being put out to the Board of Directors, said motion was carried by the following vote:

"Aye": 4; "No": 0.

The Order thus adopted is as follows:

WHEREAS, Frisco West Water Control and Improvement District of Denton County (the "District") (the "District") is a conservation and reclamation district operating under Chapters 49 and 51 of the Texas Water Code, and reserved certain rights under Chapter 53 of the Texas Water Code; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors deems it appropriate to establish rules and standards in compliance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Government Code to maintain an orderly public commentary on the Board agenda, while affording members of the public an opportunity to speak;

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF FRISCO WEST WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT OF DENTON COUNTY THAT:

Section 1. Public Comment Policy.

(a) Members of the public appearing before the Board may speak at the designated time allocated for public comment on the District Board meeting agenda. A member of the public appearing before the Board with respect to a specific agenda item on the meeting agenda will be permitted to present comments before or during the Board's consideration of the agenda item.

(b) Except as waived or otherwise authorized by a vote of the Board, in order to speak before the Board, members of the public are required to register before the call to order, using the form attached hereto.


(c) Except as waived or otherwise authorized by a vote of the Board, in order to expedite the flow of business and to provide all members of the public the opportunity to speak, the Board hereby imposes a three-minute limitation on each member of the public addressing the Board; provided, however, to the extent that a member of the public addresses the Board through a translator, the amount of time permitted under such limitation shall be doubled.

(d) Members of the public may provide comments or information in writing to the Board through correspondence addressed to the Board of Directors, Frisco West Water Control and Improvement District of Denton County, c/o Winstead PC, 2728 N. Harwood Street, Suite 500, Dallas, Texas 75201.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Order shall take effect immediately on the date set forth herein.


Section 3. Execution. The President or Vice President is authorized to execute and the Secretary or Assistant Secretary to attest this Order on behalf of the Board and District.
