

ORDER ADOPTING POLICIES REGARDING SPECIALTY STREET SIGNAGE

WHEREAS, Collin County Municipal Utility District No. 1 (the "District") is a conservation and reclamation district and political subdivision of the State of Texas existing and operating pursuant to the provisions of Article III, Section 52, and Article XVI, Section 59, of the Texas Constitution, Chapters 49 and 54, Texas Water Code, and Chapter 8164, Special District Local Laws Code (the "District Act"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Article III, Section 52(b)(3), of the Texas Constitution and the District Act, the District is authorized to construct, acquire, improve, maintain, and operate macadamized, graveled or paved roads and turnpikes, or improvements in aid thereof; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 54.205, Water Code, the District is authorized to adopt and enforce reasonable rules and regulations for the purpose, among others, of regulating privileges on any land or any easement owned or controlled by the District in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors have investigated and determined that disabled children warning signs serve to alert drivers to the possibility of disabled children playing in the area and such a sign is important since a disabled children could have difficulty recognizing an approaching passenger car, school bus, or truck; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors have determined the establishment of a policy regarding the installation of specialty street signage that serve to warn users of the District's road right-of-way of the presence of disabled children is necessary for the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Board of Directors of Collin County Municipal Utility District No. 1 that the following policies be adopted with respect to the installation of specialty signage:

1. A resident living within the District who wishes to have a disabled child warning sign installed must submit a written request to the District. The written request shall contain 1) a statement to the effect that the child is under eighteen (18) years of age, 2) that the resident agrees to follow the guidelines as detailed below, 3) contain certification of the extent of the disability from a licensed physician, audiologist, or speech and language pathologist, and 4) shall be signed and dated by the requestor. A template for such written request is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit "A".

3. Once received, the District's Board of Directors will review the request and shall determine, in its sole discretion, 1) whether a sign is justified in each circumstance and 2) what is the appropriate signage to be installed in accordance with the Texas Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices. If a sign is approved, the following guidelines shall apply:

- a. The disabled child warning sign shall be placed in accordance with the guidelines of the State of Texas.
- b. The sign placement will be reviewed every two (2) years to ensure that the requirements of the sign are still being met. The resident must re-submit an application every two (2) years during the installation of the sign.
- c. The sign or signs will be removed when the child turns eighteen (18) years old.
- d. The requestor of the sign shall be responsible for notifying the District if the family moves, the child is no longer living at the address for which the signs were placed, or the child's hearing improves to the point where the signs would not be needed.

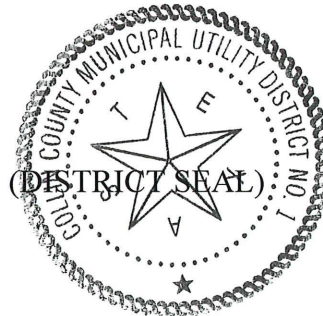
4. This Order shall become effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Board.
