Management and Operational Activities:

- **Management and Operation Updates and Items / Requests and Recommendations for Future Consideration:**
 - For the month of January 2025 Blue Line read, handled, reviewed, and/or responded to 263 emails to the GM email account and 120 emails to the Customer Service email account.
 - GM has contacted Southern Botanical for a field meeting with their crews, Landscape Development Services and Mustang SUD the meeting was tentatively set for February 6th, 2025 to finalize the separation of water meters between the districts and HOA but LDS did not get back with Southern Botanical.
 - Blue Line completed the installation of the speed limit signs on South Paloma Creek and Villa Paloma.
 - GM ordered the radar trailer and signs. Delivery is expected in March or April 2025.

- **Mustang Water Reports, Appeals, UTRWD Updates or Concerns:**
 - Blue Line handled multiple extension requests, disconnects, Adjustments, and refunds with Mustang SUD again this month.
 - UTRWD remains in Stage 2 Drought Restriction. Mustang SUD and The Districts also remain in Stage 2.

- **Trash Collection Service Updates/Issues:**

- For the month of January the GM's office continued to receive more complaints than usual regarding trash and recycling. There were a few instances of missed bins or trash, recycling and bulk being left down, but in most instances the items were recovered by Waste Connections the following day.
- GM met with Waste Connections executive and field supervisor teams on January 28th, 2025 in reference to recurring service delivery issues and missed pick ups. The Waste Connections team advised they have experienced significant turnover recently which has disrupted their operations. They assured the GM that they are working to hire competent employees but the candidate pool of drivers has been less than desirable. There are several candidates in the pipeline for hiring and once they are hired they will undergo a 9 week training program.
- A \$250 fine will be levied against WC for missing 13 recycle cans in 11B on Feb 4, 2025.

- **Public Safety / GM Liaison Committee Updates:**

- A. The last meeting was held on January 13th, 2024. Topics included receiving an update from Little Elm Police Department, new services provided by Aubrey Fire Dept, Waste Connections, Southern Botanical Landscaping, updates from the website and communications committee, an update on UTRWD Stage 2 drought restrictions, discussion regarding the funding for crossing guards for elementary schools, emergency response committee plans, bus stop concerns on South Paloma Creek and general updates from directors.

B. Emergency Management Coordinator Updates:

- i. Pending: GM will start working on an emergency operations manual that is set to be completed by first quarter 2025.
- ii. 8A BOD designated two members to regularly attend the committee meeting every month.
- iii. There are upcoming Storm Spotter training classes that will be hosted by the NWS out of Ft. Worth. Please contact GM Wilkerson if you plan on attending.

*The next PC Safety Committee meeting is scheduled for **MONDAY, February 10th, 2025 at 6:30 PM**. This is not an open public meeting as it does not meet the requirements under the Open Meetings Act as stipulated by the Office of the Attorney General of Texas.*

● **Website, Communications, and Tracker Ticket Committee Updates:**

- The last meeting occurred on December 4th. Next meeting will occur on March 5th, 2025.
- There are currently two (2) open tickets for requests to video tape or stream meetings. The boards have reviewed and considered the possibilities but no actions have been taken to date.

A. **District 8-A**

Maintenance Issues/Updates/Concerns :

1. Blue Line ordered business cards for all directors and they will be distributed at the February meeting..
2. GM is seeking additional bids for the repair of erosion at the outfall behind 1100 Heather Ln.
3. GM is looking into complaints of Little Elm ISD buses loading and unloading on South Paloma Creek at Lake Grove and causing excessive traffic delays and frustrating motorists.

Engineering Related Matters for Consideration and/or Approval:

1. GM and engineer reviewed an application from Silas White for ATT boring operations along S. Paloma Creek (600 Gammon). Engineer coordinated with Mustang SUD re 811.
2. Engineer conducted a review of current ROW plans and permit forms. Recommends updating forms for all districts.
3. GM and engineer will start inspections for the annual street maintenance project. This year, the plan is to combine all 5 districts into one project to save on mobilization fees and possibly obtain volumetric discounts on concrete and sealant.

B. District 8 B:

Maintenance Issues/Updates/Concerns :

1. Nothing to report this month.

Engineering Related Matters for Consideration and/or Approval:

1. GM and engineer reviewed current valuations on playground equipment and the lift station on Golden Eagle. No changes were recommended.
2. GM and engineer will start inspections for the annual street maintenance project. This year, the plan is to combine all 5 districts into one project to save on mobilization fees and possibly obtain volumetric discounts on concrete and sealant.

C. District 11 A:

Maintenance Issues/Updates/Concerns :

1. Blue Line is still working with GEICO to replace the damaged tree in the median reported last month under LEPD CFS 24211879. Check should be on its way to the CPA.
2. GM conveyed speeding and stop sign running concerns from directors to the Little Elm Police Department
3. GM received complaints of site line issues at S. PALOMA Creek and Bluebird. Blue Line staff confirmed there were issues and in the interest of public safety, bushes and plants were removed in certain areas to open up the site lines so motorists could see oncoming traffic when exiting the cross streets.
4. WOPAC completed installing concrete around the drop inlet at 612 New Marion Dr. Pending post work inspection and payment.

Engineering Related Matters for Consideration and/or Approval:

1. GM and engineer will start inspections for the annual street maintenance project. This year, the plan is to combine all 5 districts into one project to save on mobilization fees and possibly obtain volumetric discounts on concrete and sealant.

D. District 11 B:

Maintenance Issues/Updates/Concerns :

1. Blue Line ordered business cards for four directors and delivered them to President McClellan.
2. Southern Botanical has completed their analysis of the damages and issues in the southernmost three medians on PC. An estimate (23566) was received in the amount of \$33,899.40. Pettit is working with the developer to get this paid/installed. Need update from Pettit/Developer. ABHR to now assist.
3. 2200 block of Scott Creek: Continued oil leak issues with a resident's car. Car is now parking on the opposite side of the street and creating more oil stains. Need escalation from ABHR.
4. Blue Line continues to work with Mustang SUD regarding valve risers that are trip hazards within the district.
5. **ACTION ITEM:** GM has received 3 estimates for tree removal along the creek banks between Eppright and Abby Creek. Low bidder was Collum Tree Service in the amount of \$21,000.00. Next bidder was \$24,400 and the high bid was \$31,200. GM recommends award of bid to Collum.

Engineering Related Matters for Consideration and/or Approval:

1. GM, Engineer, and Project Manager met with 11-B president and vice president to inspect the creek channel between Eppright Dr and Abby Creek Dr. to determine a scope of work so additional grading work and erosion mitigation measures can be properly bid out.
2. Blue Line engineer reviewed construction docs, timelines, letters, etc. for Ordonez.

3. GM continues to work with 11B directors, Pettit & Blue Line engineers and subcontractors regarding the upcoming Ordonez roadway repair project.
4. GM and President McClellan walked all affected homes on Ordonez and met personally with about half of the residents in person. Letters and business cards were left on the doors if contact was not made. Construction is set to begin on 02/10/2024.
5. GM and engineer will start inspections for the annual street maintenance project. This year, the plan is to combine all 5 districts into one project to save on mobilization fees and possibly obtain volumetric discounts on concrete and sealant.

E. District 11 C:

Maintenance Issues/Updates/Concerns :

1. Blue Line crews continue to monitor trash and debris from the 11C outfall areas along Eppright Drive.
2. **ACTION ITEM:** Blue Line evaluated the need for additional speed limit signs on Rivers Creek after receiving complaints of speeding vehicles. There are no signs at this time. There are a few locations that would accommodate signs. GM requests approval for the purchase and installation of up to four (4) 30 MPH speed limit signs for this street, which sees extra traffic now due to the elementary school.

1. GM and engineer will start inspections for the annual street maintenance project. This year, the plan is to combine all 5 districts into one project to save on mobilization fees and possibly obtain volumetric discounts on concrete and sealant.
