

## Travis County MUD 11 – Highlands Streets Only

### Stage 2 Watering Restrictions Effective February 21<sup>st</sup>, 2025

Because your District's wholesale water suppliers, West Travis County Public Utility Agency initiated **Stage 2 Water Restrictions Travis County MUD 11** is required to do the same.

Only the following streets within Travis County MUD 11 are affected:

Duffy Lane, Edinburgh Isle Ct., Fraser Cove, Glenfiddich Ln., Kildrummy Ln., Princes Ct., Tavish Trail, Waverly Spire Ct., Wester Ross Lane.

- Outdoor watering hours with an **in-ground system or hose end sprinkler** will be limited to **7 p.m. to 10 p.m. & 6 a.m. to 10 a.m. **ONE**** day per week.

Addresses ending in 1 or 3	Monday
2 or 4	Tuesday
5 or 7	Wednesday
6 or 8	Thursday
9 or 0	Friday
Commercial & HOA	Saturday

- Does not apply to hand held hoses or water buckets.
- New landscapes may only be irrigated during the day and times listed above. **NO VARIANCES.**
- Filling of all new and existing pools, hot tubs, wading pools is prohibited, unless application for variance is approved on a case-by-case basis. Replenishing to maintenance level is permitted.

**Please adjust irrigation schedules to follow the “one day per week” requirements.**
