About the Department

The Elm Ridge Police Department was founded in 2018 and begin operations in January 2019. The current authorized strength of the department is twenty-five, full time Police Officers, one part-time Property Technician, and two civilians. The structure of the police department includes a Chief of Police, Police Captain, Police Lieutenant, a Criminal Investigations Sergeant, Patrol Sergeants, Detectives, a School Resource Officer, and Patrol Officers.

The department operates within four values: Service, Integrity, Transparency, and Empathy. Every decision made, whether internally or externally, is tested against these values to ensure we are abiding by our department's policing philosophy. Our philosophy, at its core, is building partnerships with our community and engaging in internal and external collaborative efforts. The pursuit of this philosophy is maintained to ensure we keep the trust of the citizens we serve as well as continually executing our public duties at the highest degree of excellence.

The police department operates 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The police department lobby is open Monday through Friday from 8:00A to 5:00P.

Vision And Mission


Vision

Officer Activity



Eighty six percent of total calls for service were self initiated by Elm Ridge Police Officers. This data reflects a very active department, which stays vigilant for criminal activity. Eighty six percent of traffic stops were issued warnings. The primary goal of Elm Ridge Police Department traffic enforcement is education and compliance, not punishment. It is also noted, \$108,728.00 of stolen property was recovered by the department.






2022-2023 Crime Trends





2023 Clearance Rate



In 2023, five hundred and eighteen reports were completed by the Elm Ridge Police Department. Three hundred and twenty six (63%) of these offenses were cleared by either on view arrests, or through the Criminal Investigations Division. One hundred and sixty nine (33%) reports were inactivated, either by insufficient evidence or no credible leads. Twenty three (4%) of the total reports generated remained active as of the end of 2023.
