How? By proactively meeting this state-wide initiative in partnership with Elston Johnson and Associates (EJA).



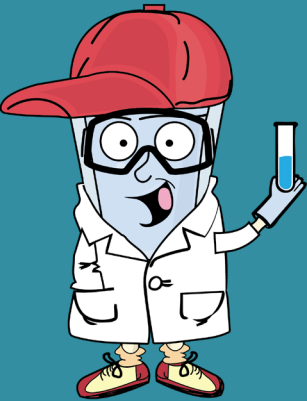

TRAINING

Train staff and help educate the community about the sources and health effects of lead in drinking water and provide the tools they need to protect children.

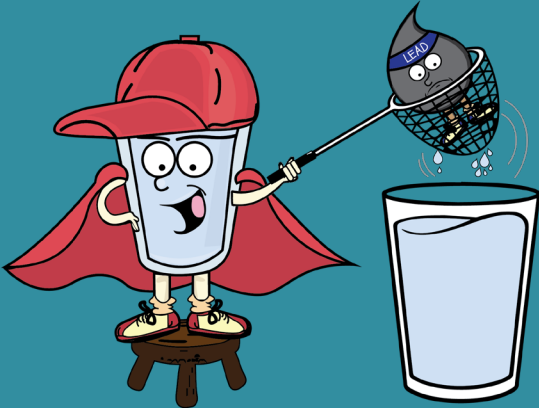


TESTING

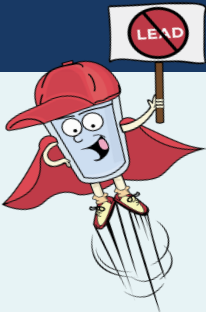
Test drinking water in schools & child care facilities to identify potential lead sources and to take actions if necessary.

TAKING ACTION

Take action to reduce lead in drinking water, with training, testing, and communication with staff and the community about risks, testing results, and recommended actions.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION



Lead is a toxic metal. When children and others are exposed to lead, it can have adverse health effects that include, reduced IQ and attention span, learning disabilities, poor classroom performance, and more. There is no safe amount of lead level for children. **Please, expect a call from EJA and be ready to answer the call so you can take action too and get tested!**
