 - Even address Thursday and Sunday
 - Odd address Wednesday and Saturday
 - o **Automatic & Manual Irrigation Systems** one day per week midnight to 10 a.m. and/or 7 p.m. to midnight
 - Even address Thursday
 - Odd address Wednesday
- Commercial / Multi-family
 - o Drip Irrigation two days per week midnight to 10 a.m. and/or 7 p.m. to midnight
 - All Addresses Tuesday and Friday
 - o **Automatic & Manual Irrigation Systems** one day per week midnight to 10 a.m. and/or 7 p.m. to midnight
 - Even Address Tuesday
 - Odd Address Friday
- Public Schools / HOAs
 - Hose-end Sprinklers & Drip Irrigation two days per week midnight to 10 a.m. and/or 7 p.m. to midnight
 - All Addresses Monday and Thursday
 - Automatic & Manual Irrigation Systems one day per week Monday midnight to 5 a.m. and/or 7 p.m. to midnight
 - All Addresses Monday
- Washing vehicles at home is permitted with a positive shutoff valve.
- Charity carwashes can be held at commercial car washes.
- Fountains must recirculate water.

Water waste is prohibited and can be enforced at all times.
