Williamson County MUD 39 Customer Service Agreement

I. PURPOSE

The Williamson County MUD 39 (the "Wastewater System") is responsible for protecting the drinking water supply from contamination or pollution that could result from improper plumbing practices. The purpose of this Customer Service Agreement (the "Agreement") is to notify each customer of the plumbing restrictions that are in place to provide this protection. The utility enforces these restrictions to ensure the public health and welfare. Each customer must sign this Agreement before the Williamson County MUD 39 will begin service. In addition, when service to an existing connection has been suspended or terminated, the waste water System will not re-establish service unless it has a signed copy of this Agreement.

II. PLUMBING RESTRICTIONS

The following unacceptable plumbing practices are prohibited by State regulations.

- A. No direct connection between the public drinking water supply and a potential source of contamination is permitted. Potential sources of contamination shall be isolated from the public water system by an air-gap or an appropriate backflow prevention device.
- B. No cross-connection between the public drinking water supply and a private water system is permitted. These potential threats to the public drinking water supply shall be eliminated at the service connection by the installation of an air-gap or a reduced pressure-zone backflow prevention device.
- C. No connection that allows water to be returned to the public water supply is permitted.
- D. No pipe or pipe fitting which contains more than 0.25% lead may be used for the installation or repair of plumbing at any connection that provides water for human use.
- E. No solder or flux that contains more than 0.2% lead can be used for the installation or repair of plumbing at any connection that provides water for human use.
- F. Plumbing installed on or after January 4, 2014 bears the expected labeling indicating less than equal to 0.25% lead content. If not properly labeled, please provide written comment.

III. CUSTOMER	SERVICE	AGREEMENT
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The following are the terms of the	Customer Service Agreement between	the Williamson County MUD
39 and	(the "Customer").	

- A. The Water System will maintain a copy of this Agreement as long as the Customer and/or the premises is connected to the waste water System.
- B. The Customer shall allow his property to be inspected for possible cross-connections and other unacceptable plumbing practices. These inspections shall be conducted by the Water System or its designated agent prior to initiating new water service; when there is reason to believe that cross-connections or other unacceptable plumbing practices exist; or after any major changes to the private plumbing facilities. The inspections shall be conducted during the Water System's normal business hours.
- C. The waste water System shall notify the Customer in writing of any cross-connection or other unacceptable plumbing practice that has been identified during the initial inspection or the periodic reinspection.
- D. The Customer shall immediately correct any unacceptable plumbing on his premises.
- E. The Customer shall, at his expense, properly install, test, and maintain any backflow prevention device required by the Water System. Copies of all testing and maintenance shall be provided to the Water System.

IV. ENFORCEMENT

If the Customer fails to comply with the terms of the Customer Service Agreement, the waste water System shall, at its option, either terminate service or properly install, test, and maintain an appropriate backflow prevention device at the service connection. Any expenses associated with the enforcement of this Agreement shall be billed to the customer.

You have recently opened your utility account and we want to provide you information about your utility billing services. Crossroads Utility Services, LLC manages the wastewater systems and the utility billing activities of Williamson County MUD 39.

The utility bills for Williamson County MUD 39 have a due date of the 15^h every month. If the due date falls on a holiday or weekend, the due date is extended to the next business day. Bills paid after 5pm on or after the due date are subject to a 10% late fee. All payments are posted to your account the business day the payment is received. Your water will be disconnected if your bill is in arrears upon notice and in accordance with Williamson County MUD 39 policies.

Payments: There are several options for paying your utility bill.

- 1. <u>Walk-in Payment</u> at our Office, Monday thru Friday from 8 am to 5 pm (closed most federal holidays). We accept cash, checks, money orders, cashier checks, and all major credit cards. Our office is located at 2601 Forest Creek Drive, Round Rock, TX 78665.
- 2. By <u>Mail</u>, with check or money order, and your payment will be credited the day that we receive it. Please <u>write your account number</u> on the check or money order. - 3. By **Phone**, with any major credit or debit card. You may also set up automatic monthly payments with your credit or debit card by phone.
